Respect for Persons

- Treat individuals as autonomous agents
- Allow people to choose for themselves
- Fundamental right to be left alone
- Extra protections for those with

diminished autonomy

Beneficence

- Maximize benefits & minimize risk of harm
- Valid Study Design
- Competent Investigators

Justice

- Burdens and benefits of research should be distributed equitably
